What is Hepatitis C?

Hepatitis is a disease characterized by inflammation or swelling of the liver. The liver is an essential organ that helps the body metabolize nutrients, filter blood, and fight off infections. Damage or inflammation of the liver, does not allow it to function properly. Hepatitis C is a serious liver illness that is caused by the Hepatitis C virus (HCV). Hepatitis C is considered a “silent disease” because people can be infected without knowing it. Some people are able to clear it, or get rid of the virus, but most people live with the virus for the rest of their lives. Physicians call this condition chronic Hepatitis C.

Is Hepatitis C curable and preventable?

Since the advent of new effective medications, HCV is now treatable for most people. Treatment differs from patient to patient; your doctor will help find the treatment that works best for you. Remember, even after treatment, it is still possible to get reinfected. You can prevent the spread of hepatitis C by getting tested, avoiding anything that has come into contact with blood and by informing yourself as much as you can about HCV. Although vaccinations exist for Hepatitis A and B, an effective Hepatitis C vaccine has yet to be developed.
