Participant should be 18 years of age or older, and wear short sleeve shirts

or loose fitting sleeves that can be rolled up.

Flu vaccinations are covered under Medicare Part B, Medicare Railroad

Part B, Medicaid, Nevada Check Up, Secure Horizons or Senior

Dimensions. For all others, the flu shot will be offered at the discounted

price of \$16.
