District to Participate in Local Observance of 17th Annual World AIDS Day

Memorial quilt displays and awareness events planned throughout week

WHAT

The 17th annual observance of World AIDS Day is December 1, 2005. Conceived and adopted in 1988 by representatives of 140 countries at the World Summit of Ministers of Health on AIDS, World AIDS Day serves as an opportunity for governments, non-governmental and local organizations, AIDS programs and individuals to demonstrate solidarity in the fight against AIDS.

The Clark County Health District will join Aid for AIDS of Nevada (AFAN), Golden Rainbow and the Clark County Coalition of HIV/AIDS Service Providers in several events throughout the week of World AIDS Day.

WHY

This year's theme, "Stop AIDS: Keep the Promise," is intended to remind worldwide leaders, health providers and organizations about our promises to continue the fight against AIDS. As of October 2005, nearly 3,000 Clark County residents are living with HIV. Since surveillance began, roughly 4,300 Clark County residents have been diagnosed with AIDS, and 2,000 of those people have died.

Local World AIDS Day events will observe the progress made in battle against HIV/AIDS, address challenges and remind the community that the epidemic is far from over.
