'Unnatural Causes: Is Inequity Making Us Sick?' First of four episodes airs Friday, March 28

Las Vegas PBS, KLVX-TV 10 will begin airing Unnatural Causes: Is Inequity Making Us Sick? at 10 p.m., Friday, March 28. This four-part documentary series explores how social conditions in which Americans are born, live and work affect their health. Weekly topics will include: "In Sickness and in Wealth," "When the Bough Breaks," Becoming American," "Bad Sugar," "Place Matters," "Collateral Damage," and "Not Just a Paycheck."
