2009 H1N1 priority groups eligible to receive the vaccine are:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel
- Persons between the ages of 6 months and 24 years old
- People ages 25-64 with chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems

The H1N1 vaccine will continue to be offered at the health district's main location on weekdays from 1 p.m. until 6 p.m. through the week of Thanksgiving.
