Health District 2009 H1N1 clinic schedule, Dec. 7-12

LAS VEGAS -- The Southern Nevada Health District continues to hold 2009 H1N1 vaccine clinics. On Friday, Dec. 11, the health district will expand vaccine availability to include people 65 and older with chronic medical conditions as well as people within the CDC-recommended priority groups. The 2009 H1N1 vaccine is available free of charge.
