Final Dust Control Workshops to be Held

(Las Vegas, Nev. – June 6, 2000) – The Clark County Health District’s (CCHD) Air Quality Division and Clark County’s Department of Comprehensive Planning will be holding a final public workshop regarding proposed regulations to control fugitive dust. The workshop takes place on June 12, 2000 at 8:00 a.m., at Las Vegas Conference Suites & Services located at 101 Convention Center Drive

Proposed regulation address fugitive dust from open areas and vacant lots; unpaved roads, alleys, easements and parking lots; paved roads and street sweeping equipment; and construction sites.

These regulations will affect property owners in Clark County and may call for the stabilization of private and public land with water, vegetation or a dust suppressant. Developers are already regulated for construction activity but several changes in the construction regulations are proposed.
