National HIV Testing Day

WHAT The Clark County Health District Office of AIDS will offer free, oral HIV testing for National HIV Testing Day. The campaign is an effort to educate the public about HIV testing, counseling and treatment.

WHY The only way to determine HIV status is through testing. It is possible to be infected with HIV and transmit the virus to others without showing any symptoms. In the United States, an estimated 800,000 to 900,000 people are infected with HIV, and approximately 250,000 of those individuals do not know it.
