West Nile Virus - Public Health Update #11

No change in the number of human cases in Clark County

October 15, 2004

For the second week in a row, the Clark County Health District noted no change in the numbers of confirmed and probable human West Nile virus cases. The current case counts are listed below.

2004 Human West Nile Virus Cases in Clark County, Nevada

^{*} The term "probable cases" describes patients with positive preliminary test results, plus symptoms and history compatible with West Nile virus infection. When a case is confirmed, it is removed from the probable count.
