## **West Nile Virus - Public Health Update #13**

Final update on the number of human cases in Clark County

October 28, 2004

In the past week, the Clark County Health District has confirmed one additional case of human West Nile virus infection. No additional probable cases have been noted. The current case counts are listed below.

## 2004 Human West Nile Virus Cases in Clark County, Nevada

<sup>\*</sup> The term "probable cases" describes patients with positive preliminary test results, plus symptoms and history compatible with West Nile virus infection. When a case is confirmed, it is removed from the probable count.
