Health district to hold flu clinic at Henderson Senior Center

(Las Vegas, Nev., - December 13, 2004) – Clark County Health District will hold a flu shot clinic on Thursday, December 16, 2004, from 8 a.m. until noon at the Henderson Senior Center, located at 27 E. Texas.

This flu shot clinic will be expanded to include the following groups:

- Persons 50 years of age and older
- Day care workers
- Health care workers
- School nurses
- Emergency Medical Services (EMS) workers
- Household contacts of high-risk individuals

High-risk individuals who have not received their vaccination are encouraged to do so.

This group includes:

- People aged 65 years and older
- People with underlying chronic medical conditions
- Women who will be pregnant during the influenza season
- Residents of nursing homes and long-term care facilities
- Health-care workers involved in direct patient care
- Out-of-home caregivers/adult household contacts of children aged <6 months

Pediatric vaccine doses are available in the regular immunization clinic at the Clark County Health District Ravenholt Public Health Center at 625 Shadow Lane and at these additional district locations:

- East Las Vegas Public Health Center, 560 N. Nellis Blvd., Suite E-12
- Henderson Public Health Center, 129 W. Lake Mead Dr., #10
- North Las Vegas Public Health Center, 1820 E. Lake Mead Blvd., Suite F

To date, health district personnel have administered more than 15,000 flu shots. Clinics will continue until supplies are depleted.
