Health District's East Las Vegas nursing clinic relocates Services resume Jan. 23

LAS VEGAS - Nursing services offered by the Southern Nevada Health District at its East Las Vegas Public Health Center will be unavailable beginning Tuesday, Jan. 17 through Thursday, Jan. 19 while the clinic is moved to a new location in the same complex. Services impacted at this location include family planning and immunization clinics. These services will be available at the Ravenholt Public Health Center and the Henderson Public Health Center. The new clinic, located at **570 N. Nellis Blvd., Ste. D-1** will reopen Monday, Jan. 23 at 8 a.m. During this time, health card services will be available at the current location, Ste. E-12. The East Las Vegas Public Health Center is open Monday through Thursday, 8 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. (closed on Friday). Services include health cards, birth/death certificates, family planning services (by appointment), children's exams (by appointment), women's healthcare services, and immunizations for adults and children.
