Las Vegas, Nev. – February 27, 2014 – Remote Area Medical Clinic, an organization dedicated to providing free quality healthcare to those in need, will host a free medical clinic for adults and children on Saturday, April 5th and Sunday, April 6th at Bonanza High School.

Free medical services include dental cleanings, fillings and extractions, complete eye exams with free prescription glasses, and women's health exam's and general medical consultations. There is no cost to patients and patients do not need to qualify to receive free services.

Parking for the event will be at the College of Southern Nevada and will open at 12:01 a.m. on Saturday (April 5) and Sunday (April 6). Numbers for clinic admission will start at 3:30 a.m. each day and admission will be on a first come, first serve basis. Patients will start to be seen at 6 a.m. on both days.

Once individuals receive their number, they must remain on the Bonanza High School campus and should come prepared to stay on-site by bringing food and blankets to stay in their automobile. Portable toilets will be available for on-site use.

There will also be a health and wellness fair on both days.


