<u>SIZE</u> :	This facility, as proposed, will consist of approximately 5.45 acres in area (of which the interior area is approximately 20,000 square feet). The maximum storage capacity is approximately 720 tons. The maximum processing rate is approximately 72 tons of accepted waste per day.
OPERATIONS:	This facility is seeking a permit from Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) to operate a medical waste management (incinerator) facility. A medical waste management facility means a facility that collects, stores, transports, transfers, processes, treats, and/or disposes of medical waste. Medical waste means any <i>solid waste</i> that is generated in the diagnosis, treatment, or immunization of human beings or animals, in research pertaining thereto, or in the production or testing of biologicals, excluding hazardous waste identified or listed under 40 CFR Part 261 or any household waste as defined in 40 CFR §261.4(b)(1). (Clark County Code Chapter 9.04.010(25)).
	The facility proposes to accept medical/infectious waste, USDA/APHIS waste, secured records requiring destruction, seized and controlled substances, expired medical products or devices. This facility will operate 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Operations include an incinerator and will take place indoors. There will be no outside storage. The facility will not be open to the public.
