<u>SIZE</u>: This facility, as proposed, will consist of approximately 435,600 square feet in area.

The maximum storage capacity is approximately 50,000 cubic yards. The maximum

processing rate is approximately 15,000 tons per day of recycled concrete.

<u>OPERATIONS</u>: This facility is seeking a permit from the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD)

to operate a recycling center. A recycling center includes a facility designed and operated to receive, store, or process recyclable materials which have been separated at the source of waste generation from other solid waste and for which there is an available market. This facility will accept concrete construction &

demolition debris. This facility will not be open to the public.
