Subsequent to our submittal of the 2008 Clark County Recycling Report to your office, an additional facility has reported their results. We have amended the Report accordingly and enclosed it herein. Our reported recycling rate increased to 18.97%, up 0.5 percentage points, while the reported tons recycled increased by nearly 2,000 to 573,708.
