

Annual Recycling Report

The State of Nevada has set a goal to recycle 25 percent of all municipal solid waste for counties with populations over 100,000. At the beginning of each year SNHD is required per NAC 444A.140 to complete a Recycling Survey and report the findings to the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection by April 1st. Measuring the recycling rate gives us an opportunity to showcase the efforts of the residents and businesses in Clark County.


For calendar year 2012, 723,395.73 tons were recycled, up 143,181 tons from 2011. The 2012 recycling rate (tons recycled/tons generated) is 27.54 percent, up 5.2 percentage points or 23.2 percent from 2011.

As noted above there has a significant increase in recycling rate for Clark County. For the first time since records started to be maintained, Clark County reached the 25 percent goal established by the State. The belief is that the increase in the recycling rate is due to the implementation of single stream recycling in a number of jurisdictions and the increased number of permitted recycling centers in Clark County. It should be noted, however, that the recycling rate would be even higher if it were not for the ongoing recycling theft problem in Clark County. Recyclable materials continue to be stolen in Clark County and taken to California to defraud the CRV and other programs.
