VIII. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & STAFF REPORTS (Information Only)

• Executive Director Comments

Dr. Leguen advised that earlier today, an opening ceremony was held at the Health Center's new East Las Vegas location. Dr. Leguen stated that this was accomplished due to a positive partnership with the City of Las Vegas, that quickly responded to the Health Center's request for a new location. This is a positive opportunity for the Health Center and Clark County residents as the new East Las Vegas location is close to a new housing development and a residential area.

Dr. Leguen confirmed that the Health Center was participating in the vaccine campaign and that the campaign has expanded to children 5-11 years old. Last week, the Health Center had an opening ceremony for the commencement of the pediatric vaccine campaign that was held at the main facility at 280 S Decatur Boulevard.

Dr. Leguen advised that as of today, all the Health Center employees have either initiated or completed the vaccination process, except for two. This is a great accomplishment as the Health Center is close to 100% compliance with the federal vaccine mandate.

Member Melendrez congratulated Dr. Leguen for the efforts in reaching close to 100% of vaccinated employees.
