The notice shall include the time, place, location, and agenda of the hearing. Individuals may request notice, but a request for notice lapses six months after it is made. The Southern Nevada District Board of Health informs each requestor of this fact by this notation on the copy of the notice mailed to them.

7)Contract with licensed plumber to make all necessary repairs to common areas of sewer system within sixty (60) days. Provide proof to SNHD within fifteen (15) days after contracting deadline.

8) Complete all necessary repairs to common elements of sewer system within one-hundred eighty (180) days.

9) Provide proof of repairs to SNHD no later than fifteen (15) days after repair completion deadline.

10) Provide update documenting all repairs completed to SNHD within one-hundred twenty (120) days.

11) Cease and desist causing or allowing to cause any sewage or accumulation of human excreta to overflow and deposit at this property or any other property in Clark County, Nevada.
