That the Southern Nevada Health District Board of Health approve Augmentation to the SNHD Bond Reserve (Building) Fund Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2017 to meet the mandatory requirements of NRS 354.598005

DISCUSSION:

The augmentation procedure as prescribed by NRS 354.598005 defines when to perform an augmentation for a fund.

When the budget was prepared and approved in March of 2016, it was believed that funds needed would be minimal for unforeseen upgrades to Health District facilities during the 2016/17 fiscal year. Improvements to the Laboratory were completed to enable the Health District to perform clinical laboratory services in-house. The costs for these improvements were \$347,245. Additional transfer of funds for \$550,000 related to roof renovations was also transferred to the Bond Reserve (Building) Fund. Thereby the remaining fund balance increased to \$1,598,072.

To complete the augmentation process, the attached Resolution to Augment SNHD Bond Reserve (Building) Fund Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2017 must be adopted. The Resolution will be forwarded to the Nevada Department of Taxation after the adoption of the Resolution to Augment is done.

RESOLUTION # 01-17

RESOLUTION TO AUGMENT THE 2016-2017 BUDGET OF SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT

WHEREAS, total resources of the Bond Reserve (Building) Fund, Southern Nevada Health District were budgeted to be \$ 225,000 on July 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the total available resources are now determined to be \$ 1,963,072 and

WHEREAS, said additional unanticipated resources are as follows:

Bond Reserve (Building Fund):

Ending Fund Balance from 6/30/2016 \$ 57,433 Operating Transfer In (from fund 7050) \$ 550,000

Total \$ 607,433

WHEREAS, there is a need to apply these excess proceeds in the Bond Reserve (Building) Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED, that the Southern Nevada Health District shall augment its 2016-2017 budget by appropriating \$ 140,000 for use in the Bond Reserve (Building) Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$ 225,000 to \$ 365,000. A detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Southern Nevada Health District shall forward the necessary documents to the Department of Taxation, State of Nevada.
