#### RE: DIVISION OF CLINICAL SERVICES DIRECTOR REPORT

#### I. Immunization Program

#### A. Immunization Program Activities

- There were 129 successful reminder calls and postcards were sent out on January 15, 2020 to children, 6 weeks through 4 years, without the appropriate number of Prevnar doses.
- 2. There were 148 reminder calls made to parents of children 19-35 months who are not up to date with their immunizations in January.
- 3. A total of 73 reminder calls were made to individuals who did not complete his/her Human Papilloma vaccine (HPV) series in January.
- 4. More than 100 stuffed toys were distributed to children who received vaccinations in January. The stuffed toys were donated by Carrie Jepson, RN.

#### B. Immunization Outreach Mobile Unit Clinics

- 1. Skyview YMCA North Las Vegas Clinic was held on January 13, 2020. No clients were seen. This was the last scheduled clinic at Skyview.
- 2. Alexander Library North Las Vegas Clinic was held on January 14, 2020. Three clients received 4 vaccines. This location will replace the Skyview YMCA location. An amendment to the MOU for the City of North Las Vegas in process.
- 3. West Las Vegas Windmill Library Clinic was held on January 15, 2020. Four clients received 9 vaccines.
- 4. Clark County East Las Vegas Library Clinic was held on January 22, 2020. Eight clients received 15 vaccines.
- 5. Henderson Morrel Park Clinic was held on January 28, 2020. One client received 2 vaccines.

#### C. <u>Immunization Outreach Clinics</u>

- A total of 104 clients received 188 vaccines at various clinics; Las Vegas tunnels, Nevada Homeless Alliance Pop-Up Clinic at Whitney Community Center, Las Vegas Rescue Mission and Impact Center in partnership with Help of Southern Nevada.
- 2. Clark County Detention Center Clinics provided 179 vaccines to 104 clients.
- 3. The SNHD Decatur Clinic provided Hepatitis A vaccines provided 95 vaccines to 95 clients.
- 4. A Mobile Health Collaborative Community meeting was held on January 29, 2020 and was attended by Sarah Lugo and Chika McTier.

#### II. Community Health Nursing

#### A. Maternal Child Health

- 1. There were no new reported cases of childhood lead poisoning in January.
- 2. There were eight referrals from the Newborn Screening Program requiring follow-up by the field nurse.

#### B. Nurse Family Partnership (NFP)

The Southern Nevada Health District's Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) has 176 active clients. Fifty-three are participating through the Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) Program made available through the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health under the Affordable Care Act (ACA).

#### C. Embracing Healthy Baby

The Southern Nevada Health District's Embracing Healthy Baby program continues to develop. Ongoing training with the program supervisor on maternal child health topics and their program role continues for the Community Health Workers (CHWs). The CHWs completed joint home visits with the Maternal Child Health nurse assigned to the program and are involved in the joint management of cases. Program outreach this month included seven Women Infants and Children locations, Women's Health Associates of Southern Nevada, Sunrise Hospital's Sunny Babies Program, University Medical Center's Women's Resource Center, East Las Vegas Community Center, Baby's Bounty, Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, City of Las Vegas Family Engagement Collaborative, Clark County Department of Welfare and Social Services, Nurse-Family Partnership's Community Coalition, Southern Nevada Early Childhood Advisory Council, Southern Nevada Maternal Child Health Coalition, Health Plan of Nevada and Anthem.

#### III. Tuberculosis Clinic

- A. Four new active adult TB cases were reported during January.
- B. There were no new pediatric TB cases during January.

#### IV. Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP)

- A. The TPP program and grant partners continue full program and grant activities at the Juvenile Justice System, Department of Family Services, and other community-based organizations.
- B. Special Projects, Reports/Events: During January, the TPP program conducted outreach activities at Las Vegas High School, El Dorado High School, Chaparral High School and Desert Pines High School. The Teen Pregnancy Prevention program provided information and resources to 600 individuals.
- C. During January, through the TPP program's social media campaign the THNKnevada Facebook page has a total of 5,874 likes. The twitter account has 725 followers and had 1,962 impressions. The THNK website had 158 unique pageviews, 112 new users and

15 returning users and the Instagram page reached 922 followers and 732 youth were engaged.

#### V. Clinical Services Administration

A. Clinical Services Division continues to retain Nevada State Board of Nursing approval to provide Continuing Education credits for SNHD Nursing staff. There were no CEU's offered in January.
