RE: DIVISION OF CLINICAL SERVICES DIRECTOR REPORT

I. Immunization Program

A. Immunization Program Activities

1. There were 553 successful reminder calls and postcards sent out to adults 65 years and older who did not receive their doses of Prevnar, Pneumovax and/or Td/Tdap vaccination in February.
2. There were 141 reminder calls made to parents of children 19-35 months who are not up to date with their immunizations in February.
3. A total of 144 reminder calls were made to individuals who did not complete his/her Human Papilloma vaccine (HPV) series in February.
4. The last day of immunization services at Henderson/Touro Clinic was Friday, February 28, 2020.

B. Immunization Outreach Mobile Unit Clinics

1. Windmill Library Clinic was held on February 19, 2020 and provided 5 vaccines to 3 clients.
2. Morrell Park Henderson Clinic was held on February 25, 2020 and provided 2 vaccines to one client.
3. Clark County Library Clinic was held on February 26, 2020 and provided 6 vaccines to four clients.

C. Immunization Outreach Clinics

1. A total of 194 clients received 282 vaccines at various outreach clinics; Trac B, Westcare (woman and children locations), US Vets, Pop-Up at Cambridge Center, tunnels, Impact Center, Catholic Charities and the Mission Treatment Center.
2. Hepatitis A Sexual Health Clinic provided 34 vaccines to 34 clients.
3. Clark County Detention Center and City Jail clinics provided 171 vaccines to 171 clients. The initial City Jail Clinic was held on February 28, 2020 and provided 47 vaccines to 47 clients.

D. Community Meetings

1. Staff attend the Southern Nevada Homeless Continuum of Care meeting on February 11, 2020.
2. Staff attended the Nevada Homeless Alliance meeting on February 12, 2020.
3. Staff attended the City Jail meeting on February 27, 2020.

II. Community Health Nursing

A. Maternal Child Health

1. There were no new reported cases of childhood lead poisoning in February.
2. There were six referrals from the Newborn Screening Program requiring follow-up by the field nurse.

B. Nurse Family Partnership (NFP)

The Southern Nevada Health District's Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) has 175 active clients and seven Nurse Home visitors. Fifty-two clients are participating through the Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) Program made available through the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health under the Affordable Care Act (ACA). The program consistently meets the MIECHV requirement for number of clients served.

C. Embracing Healthy Baby

The Southern Nevada Health District's Embracing Healthy Baby program continues to develop. Ongoing training with the program supervisor on maternal child health topics continues for the Community Health Workers (CHWs). The CHWs are managing cases with guidance from the Community Health Nurse Supervisor. Program outreach this month included Women Infants and Children locations within the targeted zip codes; Women's Health Associates of Southern Nevada; East Valley Family Services; Dignity Health's MOM 2020 Mental Health Forum; Southern Nevada Breastfeeding Coalition; Walnut Community Center; Pearson Community Center; Lied Memorial Family Resource Center; Southern Nevada Maternal Child Health Coalition; and the East Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, Alexander, Spring Valley, Rainbow and Clark County Libraries. The CHWs also attended a Mental Health First Aid training

III. Tuberculosis Clinic

- A. Six new adult adult TB cases were reported by the TB Clinic during this period. There was one new pediatric TB case.
- B. The Refugee Health Program served 22 adults in February.

IV. Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP)

- A. The TPP program and grant partners continue full program and grant activities at the Juvenile Justice System, Department of Family Services, and other community-based organizations.
- B. Special Projects, Reports/Events: During February, the TPP program conducted outreach activities at El Dorado High School, Rancho High School and Western High School. The Teen Pregnancy Prevention program provided information and resources to 505 individuals. TPP staff facilitated a community presentation at UNLV's School of Health Sciences.
- C. During February, through the TPP program's social media campaign the THNKnevada Facebook page has a total of 5,837 likes. The twitter account has 726 followers and had 2,195 impressions. The THNK website had 129 unique pageviews, 62 new users and 8 returning users and the Instagram page reached 942 followers and 54 youth were engaged.

V. Clinical Services Administration

- A. Clinical Services Division continues to retain Nevada State Board of Nursing approval to provide Continuing Education credits for SNHD Nursing staff. There were no CEU's offered in February.
