RE: DIVISION OF CLINICAL SERVICES DIRECTOR REPORT

I. Immunization Program

A. <u>Immunization Program Activities</u>

A. Immunization Program Activities

- 1. Due to COVID 19, immunization services continued to be available by appointments only throughout the month of July at all clinic locations.
- 2. Henderson Immunization Clinic on 220 E. Horizon Drive opened on July 1, 2020. A total of 204 clients with 383 vaccines administered.
- In preparation for Back to School, annual immunization training was completed through CDC You Call the Shots modules instead of in-person training. Those who administer vaccines also completed the Skill Checklist to demonstrate competency.

B. Immunization Outreach Activities

- Immunization Outreach team continue to assist the ICS community testing at homeless encampments in partnership with Help of Southern Nevada and receive referrals from Office of Epidemiology.
- 2. Mobile clinics resumed services for the month of July in preparation for back to school. The mobile unit conducted clinics at 4 locations on a weekly basis from July 6, 2020, through August 13, 2020.
 - Mondays at Windmill library from 10 am -1pm
 - Tuesdays at Consulate of El Salvador from 9am-12 pm
 - Wednesdays at Clark County library from 10am-1pm
 - Thursdays at Alexander library from 10am-1pm.
 - Windmill library had a total of 29 clients and administered 50 vaccines to children and adults.
 - Consulate of El Salvador had a total of 18 clients and administered 50 vaccines to children and adults.
 - Clark County library had a total of 11 clients and administered 23 vaccines to children and adults.
 - Alexander library had 19 clients and administered 45 vaccines to children and adults.

Total clients seen in the mobile clinic for July 2020 - 77 clients and 168 vaccines administered to children and adults.

Back to school event at Mater Academy on 7/29/2020, provided services to 30 clients and administered 64 vaccines to children and adults.

Meetings attended by staff- the annual Nevada State Immunization Program (NSIP) meeting was held via Webex on July 22, 2020. Discussions included planning for the Flu season, flu grants and updates on the various State immunization programs.

II. Community Health Nursing

A. Maternal Child Health

- 1. There was one new reported childhood lead case for the month of July.
- 2. There were three referrals from the Newborn Screening Program requiring follow-up by the field nurse.

B. Nurse Family Partnership (NFP)

The Southern Nevada Health District's Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) has 170 active clients served by seven nurse home visitors. 52 clients are participating through the Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) Program made available through the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health under the Affordable Care Act (ACA). The newly hired, eighth nurse home visitor began employment this month and is undergoing orientation into the program. The program convened a virtual community meeting July 9, 2020.

The program continues to provide information, guidance, support and resources to clients using telehealth on a regular basis.

C. Embracing Healthy Baby

The Southern Nevada Health District's Embracing Healthy Baby program continues ongoing training on maternal child health topics. The Community Health Workers (CHW) are managing cases with minimal guidance from the program Community Health Nurse. Telephone visits are currently being conducted with enrolled families. Education and referrals to needed services continue to be provided to families. The team received training on conducting virtual visits via the electronic medical record system. Program outreach occurred via email during the month of July due to the closure of community agencies or shift to remote work. Outreach occurred with the Boys and Girls Club, Nevada Health Centers, Three Square, the Immigrant Home Foundation, Acelero Head Start, Silver Summit and Liberty Dental.

III. Tuberculosis Clinic

- A. One new active adult TB case was reported by the TB Clinic during this period. There were no new pediatric cases.
- B. The Refugee Health Program served 30 adults in July.

IV. Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP)

- A. The TPP program's official end date of June 30, 2020 was extended to October 30, 2020 with a no cost extension. The TPP program and grant partners continue full program and grant activities at the Juvenile Justice System, Department of Family Services, and other community-based organizations.
- B. Due to the COViD-19 pandemic and restrictions imposed by the program site partners and by the State's Governor, program activities have been placed on hold.

V. Clinical Services Administration

A. Clinical Services Division continues to retain Nevada State Board of Nursing approval to provide Continuing Education credits for SNHD Nursing staff. There were no CEU's offered in July.
