# Mobile Vending

- Permitting
  - Governed by NRS 446 and Chapter 10 of the SNHD Food Regulations
  - Allows the Truck to Offer Food to the Public
- Fees
  - Plan Review \$479
  - Annual Permit \$244
- Permit Holder Responsibilities
  - Comply with Statutes and Regulations
  - May Not Operate Within 250 Feet of Another Mobile Vendor
  - May Not Operate at One Location for more than 30 Minutes/Day
    - Waiver Available to Operate for up to 4 Hours at a Location

# Special Events

- Permitting
  - Governed by NRS 446 and Chapter 15 of the SNHD Food Regulations
  - Temporary Events up to 14 Days
  - Temporary Food Establishments (TFE) for Food Booths
  - No Additional Permitting for Mobile Vendors
    - Is included in the Vendor Count for the Event
    - When in a Special Event, they Follow those Regulations
      - No 30-minute Limit, No Requirement to be Spaced Apart
  - Event Coordinator (EC)
    - Required when there are Multiple Food Vendors at an Event
    - Tasting Events are included with this Permit

# Special Events

- Fees
  - Mobile Vendors \$0.00 (Already Permitted)
  - Temporary Food Establishment
    - 1-5 Days \$131
    - 6-10 Days \$160
    - 11-14 Days \$198
  - Event Coordinator
    - Traditional (TFE/Mobile Vendor only)
      - 2-10 Vendors \$145
      - 11-60 Vendors \$290
      - 61+ Vendors \$290 + Hours
    - Tasting Event
      - \$290
      - Additional Charges for Booths

# Special Events

- Temporary Food Establishments Responsibilities
  - Food Safety at their Food Booth
- Mobile Vendors at Special Events
  - Same as Temporary Food Establishments
- Event Coordinators
  - Auxiliary Services for the Events
    - Trash Disposal
    - Public Restrooms and Handwashing Stations
    - Grey Water Storage and Removal
    - Overall Sanitation Compliance for the Event
    - Dishwashing Facilities for Events 3 Days or More
    - Food Safety in Tasting Events



# Mobile Vendors at Special Events

- No Additional Permitting for Mobile Vendors
- Mobile Vendors counted in the Total Vendor Count
- The Event Coordinator Permit Fee is Based on the Number of Vendors
- The Event Coordinator is Necessary to Ensure that Auxiliary Services are Provided to the Vendors.
- The Event Coordinator Acts as the Liaison to the SNHD to Ensure that the Event does not Create a Public Health Hazard or Public Nuisance.
