The Parties each acknowledge that for the safety of others, individuals awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test should not enter public buildings, including libraries. At Library District's request, and with reasonable notice, Health District will display mutually agreed-upon signage outside of Mobile Clinics on Library District property instructing individuals who are not certain of their COVID-19 status to avoid entering public buildings, including libraries. Except as expressly provided in this Amendment A01, all the terms and provisions of the MOU are and will remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed by the Parties.

AMENDMENT A01 TO INTERLOCAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT AND LAS VEGAS-CLARK COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT C2100005

THIS AMENDMENT A01 IS MADE WITH REFERENCE TO Interlocal Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), Effective Date September 1, 2020, by and between the Southern Nevada Health District ("Health District") and Las Vegas-Clark County Library District ("Library District") (individually referred to as "Party" and collectively, as "Parties").

WHEREAS, the Parties mutually desire to add language reflecting current events concerning COVID-19 in southern Nevada.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 10 of the MOU, the Parties agree to amend the MOU as follows:

- 1) Section 20, General COVID-19-Related Considerations, is hereby added to the MOU:
 - 20. GENERAL COVID-19-RELATED CONSIDERATIONS. The Parties each acknowledge that for the safety of others, individuals awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test should not enter public buildings, including libraries. At Library District's request, and with reasonable notice, Health District will display mutually agreed-upon signage outside of Mobile Clinics on Library District property instructing individuals who are not certain of their COVID-19 status to avoid entering public buildings, including libraries.
