FREE Las Vegas Lead-Based Paint and Home Assessment

GET YOUR HOME TESTED

- Pre-1978 homes in Nevada may contain lead-based paint.
- Children are most at risk for exposure to lead-based paint.
- In children, lead-based paint may cause learning disabilities, behavior problems, or even death.
- Health and safety hazards in your home may be harming your family's health.

SERVICES OFFERED

- Lead-based paint and healthy homes assessments
- If a lead hazard is found:
 - Repair or removal of lead-based paint
 - Home repairs (e.g., electrical, plumbing, windows)
 - Blood lead testing for young children

The program is free to Las Vegas residents — both homeowners and renters — who meet the following criteria:

- Live in a home built before 1978
- Have at least one child under 6 years old living or frequently visiting the home
- Meet HUD income guidelines
