


SCENARIO



BUSINESS GROWS AND GROWS


We should hire more artists. They can use our business name and whatever they make, we can get a portion.

Good idea! If we add more workstations, we need to apply for a remodel with SNHD first. But, at least we already have the health permits that we need.




LATER DOWN THE LINE...
