SNHD Pediatric Early Warning Sentinel Surveillance (PEWSS) Report: October 13, 2010

All Reporting Sites, Through the Week Ending October 09, 2010

General Update

The Pediatric Early Warning Sentinel Surveillance (PEWSS) has detected Adenovirus and Parainfluenza 1 for the week ending October 9, 2010. Each virus was detected once, and from different patient specimens.

Although the seasonal emergence of respiratory viruses in the upcoming months is expected, the current levels of activity in all ten of the respiratory viruses that PEWSS monitor appear to be low in southern Nevada.
