## SNHD Pediatric Early Warning Sentinel Surveillance (PEWSS) Report: December 29, 2010

All Reporting Sites, Through the Week Ending December 25, 2010

## **General Update**

The Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) Pediatric Early Warning Sentinel Surveillance (PEWSS) has detected Adenovirus, Influenza B, Human Parainfluenza Virus 1 and RSV for the week ending December 25, 2010.

Influenza B was detected in 36% of patient specimens submitted, an increase over the previous week (Table 1). Antigenic characterization performed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention indicates that the influenza B strain circulating nationwide is identical to that strain that is contained in the 2010-2011 vaccine.

Parainfluenza 2 continues to circulate in the community, and has been identified in a single patient specimen in each of the past three weeks.

RSV also continues to circulate in the community; the majority of cases have been identified in children aged one through four. RSV activity typically occurs through March, and is highest during the month of January.
