Severity of Illness: Explain two complications of influenza	Discuss those at risk and the complications of influenza	3 minutes			
Treatment: Describe two treatments for influenza	Discuss antiviral medications and care of those with influenza	4 minutes			
Benefit of Vaccine: Name two benefits of being vaccinated	Discuss how vaccination prevents infection and decreases disease burden	4 minutes			
Non-vaccine Control and Prevention: Name two methods of preventing the spread of influenza in addition to vaccination	Discuss influenza prevention hygienic methods (cover cough, wash hands)	4 minutes			
Vaccine Efficacy and Safety: Name one type of influenza vaccination and what population would receive it	Provide information about vaccine safety and efficacy, including types, recommendations, precautions, contraindications, side effects	5 minutes
