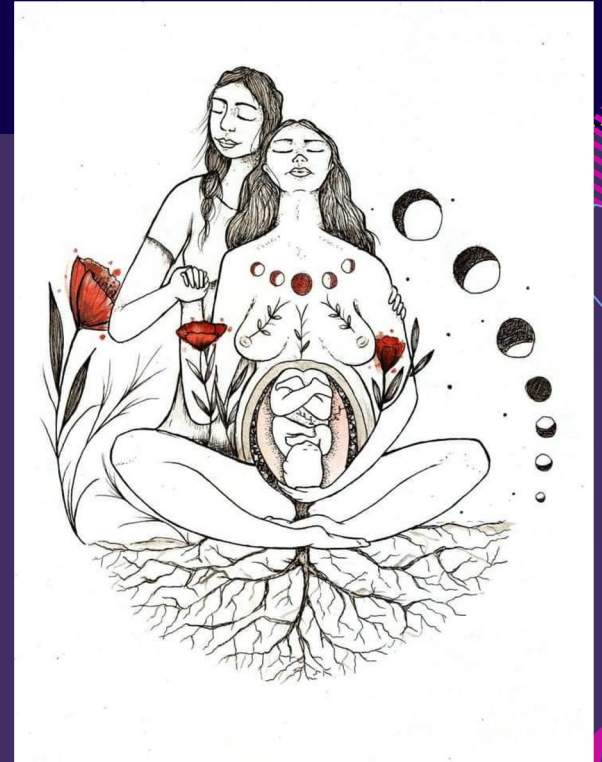

 - traditional healers



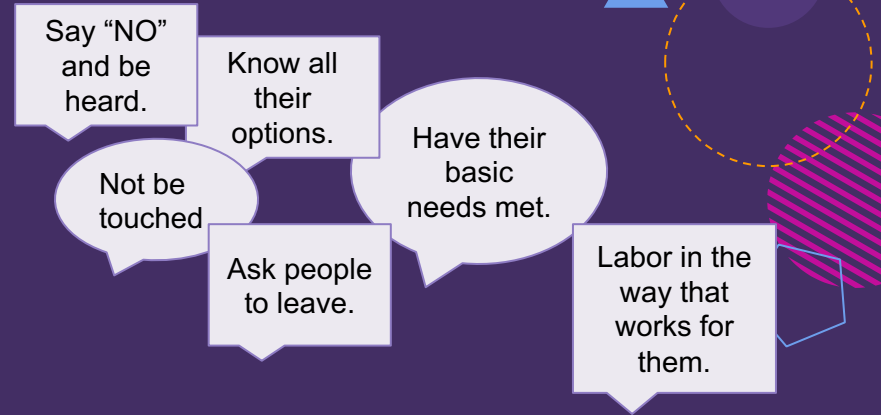

Patient/Birth Rights

- Your right to bodily autonomy
- Your right to fair and equal treatment
- Your right to informed consent and refusal
- Hospital
 - Even when you've signed a consent form at the hospital, you have the right to change your mind and/or not give consent in the moment.
 - Each hospital will have their own "bill of rights" that is provided to patients. This might be something folx can ask for when they do their hospital tours.
