A GUIDE TO LIQUID WASTE HAULING PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS

New Permit Requirements: All new businesses wishing to haul liquid waste are required to submit a Liquid Waste Hauling Plan Review application for their business and any trucks that will be hauling liquid waste. All trucks will require an inspection prior to receiving a permit to operate. Appointments for inspection cannot be made until the application is returned and payment is verified. The application can be submitted and payment made in one of the following ways:

- In Person at the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) office located at 280 S Decatur Blvd. Counter hours are from 8am-3:30pm, Monday through Friday, and the counter is closed for lunch between 12:30pm-1:30pm.
- The application can be returned by email. The invoice will be forwarded and payment can be made online at <http://snhd.info/eh/payment>. All major credit cards are accepted. Payments made online require 2 business days to process before an inspection can be scheduled.

Liquid Waste Hauling Fees:

Liquid Waste Hauling Business	\$319.00 per year
Liquid Waste Hauling Truck	\$88.00 per truck each year

****All permits are valid for the calendar year. Permit fees are not prorated****

Liquid Waste Hauling Truck Identification Requirements: Once the paperwork is received and processed, then a permit number will be assigned to your business and each vehicle applying for permitting. You will be contacted by SNHD and given the permit numbers, so you can prepare the labeling for the vehicle identification requirement before the vehicle inspection. The identification labels should be at least 2" in height and in a contrasting color to the truck. The following required information is to be shown on both sides of the vehicle:

If your truck is an "all in one" unit, your labeling may be shown on the doors or on the side of the vehicle. If you are only permitting the tanker portion then the labeling needs to be shown on both sides of the tanker itself.

Annual Renewal/Inspection: All trucks must pay the permitting fees and pass an annual inspection prior to permits being issued for the following calendar year. Annual truck inspections start in November or whenever SNHD sends permit renewal invoices. Truck inspections are **appointment only** and will be inspected at the following location: **Southern Nevada Health District Parking Lot** located at **280 S Decatur Blvd.**

Adding/Deleting Trucks: All businesses are responsible for notifying SNHD of any changes to their fleet including the addition or removal of trucks from service. All existing liquid waste hauling businesses can submit changes to SNHD using the Liquid Waste Hauler Permit Modification sheet (Page 4). The addition of new vehicles requires a copy of the vehicle's registration to be submitted and appropriate fees to be paid.

All vehicle inspections are made by appointment only. Failure to show for a scheduled appointment can result in a missed appointment fee. 3. All applicable fees are collected at the time of appointment. Fees are nonrefundable. 4. Waste from sand-oil-water separators must not be blended with other liquid waste. 5. Agree to the recordkeeping and documentation requirements for liquid waste hauling. 6. All waste must be stored or unloaded at a permitted disposal facility. Failure to do so may result in fines and/or permit revocation. 			
Acceptable forms of payment include: Cash, Credit / Debit Card with matching ID (Visa / MC / AMEX), Money Orders or Business Check (not starter).			
APPLICANT SIGNATURE (OWNER / REPRESENTATIVE)			
The business and its drivers will agree to comply with SNHD Regulations Governing Individual Sewage Disposal Systems and Liquid Waste Management. All waste material collected will be disposed of in accordance with these Regulations and that such waste will not be discharged to a waterway, sewer, or deposited on land without prior approval of the Health Authority.
