- Orchids Garden Chinese Restaurant (PR0016843, PR0016845, and PR0016847):
   Before starting the review of evidence and testimony, SNHD staff and Orchids Garden owners and representatives met to discuss alternatives to permit revocation. SNHD staff and Orchids Garden owners and representatives reached a settlement agreement to allow the facility to open and operate again with the following stipulations:
  - Facility will have weekly visits from a Food Safety Consultant for the next eighteen (18) months.
  - Facility will have a Food Safety Manager onsite at all operating times.
  - Facility will have unannounced quarterly inspections for the next eighteen (18) months.
     All inspections must pass with an "A" grade (10 demerits or less).

- Facility staff will schedule a reinspection prior to reopening. The reinspection must pass with an "A" grade (10 demerits or less).
- Pay all applicable fees.
- If any inspection within the next eighteen (18) months results in a grade other than an "A" (10 demerits or less), all permits will be revoked without further administrative process or hearing.
