# SNHD Pediatric Early Warning Sentinel Surveillance (PEWSS) Report: January 04, 2012 All Reporting Sites, Through the Week Ending December 30, 2011

#### **General Update**

During the week ending December 30, 2011, the following virus was identified through PEWSS with a low volume of testing (Fig. 1): RSV.

Over the past five weeks (Tables 1 & 2), the following were identified in the community through PEWSS: Adenovirus, Parainfluenza 1 and RSV have been circulating at low levels. Influenza A, Human Metapneumovirus and Parainfluenza 2 have been sporadically identified. Influenza B and Parainfluenza 3 have not been identified.




