General Update

During the week ending July 13, 2013, no viruses were identified through PEWSS with a low volume of testing (Fig. 1)

Over the past five weeks (Tables 1 & 2), the following were identified in the community through PEWSS: Adenovirus has been circulating at low levels.

Human Metapneumovirus, Parainfluenza 1 and Parainfluenza 3 have been sporadically identified. Influenza A, Influenza B, Parainfluenza 2 and RSV have not been identified.





Other News and Information

PEWSS did not detect any of the surveyed respiratory viruses this surveillance period (Table 1).

The weekly number of specimens tested (Fig. 1) is also low at this time, which suggests program sentinel clinicians are not currently encountering many children who met the PEWSS testing criteria (fever >100°F accompanied by a cough and/or sore throat) in order to collect samples.
