General Update

During the week ending July 20, 2013, the following virus was identified through PEWSS with a low volume of testing (Fig. 1): Adenovirus.

Over the past five weeks (Tables 1 & 2), the following were identified in the community through PEWSS: Adenovirus has been circulating at low levels.

Parainfluenza 1 and Parainfluenza 3 have been sporadically identified.

Influenza A, Influenza B, Human Metapneumovirus, Parainfluenza 2 and RSV have not been identified.





Other News and Information

PEWSS sentinel clinicians are submitting a low number of specimens for testing (Fig. 1), which suggests that they are not currently encountering many children who meet the PEWSS testing criteria (fever >100°F accompanied by a cough and/or sore throat) in order to collect samples.

However, in view of the markedly increased incidence of pertussis in the community, please consider pertussis in your evaluation of an illness with coughing.
