General Update

During the week ending August 10, 2013, the following virus was identified through PEWSS with a low volume of testing (Fig. 1): Adenovirus.

Over the past five weeks (Tables 1 & 2), the following were identified in the community through PEWSS: Adenovirus has been circulating at low levels.

Influenza A has been sporadically identified.

Influenza B, Human Metapneumovirus, Parainfluenza 1, Parainfluenza 2, Parainfluenza 3 and RSV have not been identified.




