## **General Update**

During the week ending December 28, 2013, the following viruses were identified through PEWSS with a low volume of testing (Fig. 1): Influenza A, Human Metapneumovirus, Parainfluenza 1 and RSV.

Over the past five weeks (Tables 1 & 2), the following were identified in the community through PEWSS:

Human Metapneumovirus and Parainfluenza 1 have been circulating at low levels.

Influenza A and RSV have been sporadically identified.

Influenza B, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza 2 and Parainfluenza 3 have not been identified.





## **Other News and Information**

The only influenza virus PEWSS has detected since October 1, 2013 is 2009 H1N1 (Fig. 2). The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports that all 2009 H1N1 viruses tested by U.S. laboratories this flu season were characterized as A/California/7/2009-like, the influenza A (H1N1) component of the 2013-2014 Northern Hemisphere influenza vaccine.

While flu is circulating in the community, receiving the yearly flu vaccine is the best way to prevent a flu infection.
