Figure 1. Weekly number of specimens tested

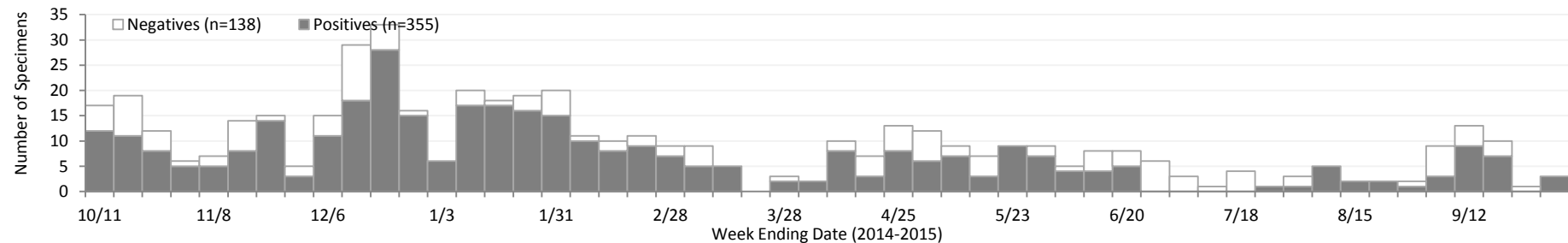


Figure 2. Weekly positive counts for organisms identified
