

## Public Health Update Nationwide Shortages of Reagents for Testing SARS-CoV-2 Virus March 17, 2020

## Situation

Due to nationwide shortages of reagents for testing SARS-CoV-2 virus, the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) has exhausted our current supply of reagents and must cease testing immediately. SNHD advises sending SARS-Cov-2 samples to the reference laboratory of your choice (Quest Diagnostics or LabCorp) until further notice. The link below has example reference laboratories now performing the test.
