We accept any photo identification that includes a photo of you. **You will not be turned away due to inability to pay on the day of your visit** (if you are a teen, you will only be asked for a donation).

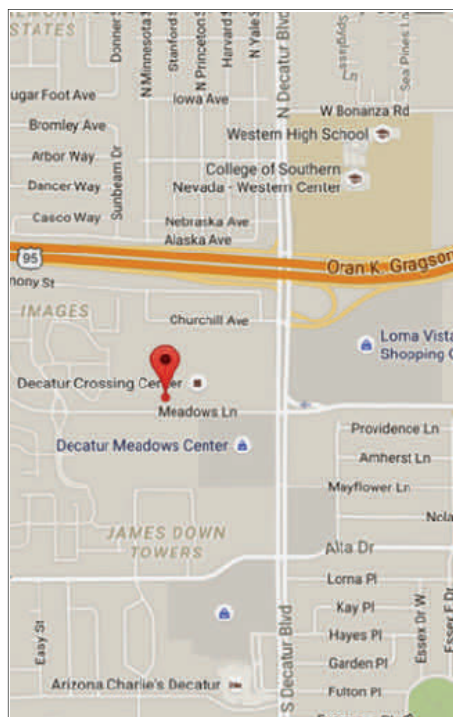
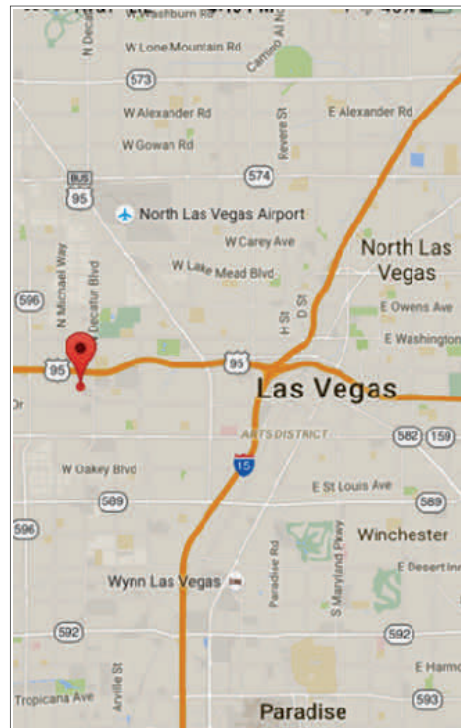
* Clients seeking treatment at the Sexual Health Clinic should know that the health district is required to report cases involving assault or abuse to appropriate agencies.
