Year 3 Quarter 1 Results: September 1-November 30, 2012

In general, participants in year 3 are reporting extremely favorable views about both the *¡Cuidate!* and *Be Proud Be Responsible* curricula, about their facilitators, and about the value of the curricula to participants.

The number of cases is very small and conclusions must be very tentative.

- 98-99% of year 3 participants held a favorable view overall of their educational experience, up from 93% in year 2. An "overall favorable" view means that on average the participant agreed or strongly agreed with positive statements about five aspects of the educational interventions.
- ¡Cuidate! was provided only in probation facilities, but was viewed at least as favorably as BPBR among the probation teens.

To extract useful areas for inquiry from these data, we may wish to focus primarily on the following areas where mean ratings were at or below 4.6:

- 1. The means for "liked activities" were often lower than those for other questions, especially in probation and for ¡Cuidate! (Table 3)
- 2. Probation participants who received BPBR did not report learning as much as other participants (Tables 3 & 4)
- 3. BPBR participants in probation and (surprisingly) in E-3 Detention were less likely than many others to recommend the program (Table 4)
- 4. Black teens in probation gave lower ratings to the training than did other races in probation (Table 5)
- 5. Black teens gave higher ratings to ¡Cuidate! than to BPBR (Table 7)
- 6. Hispanic teens gave higher ratings to BPBR than to ¡Cuidate! (Tables 7 & 8)
- 7. Females in probation gave very low ratings to the training (Table 9) compared to males in probation
- 8. Females gave lower ratings to ¡Cuidate! than males (Table 10)
- 9. Females gave higher ratings to BPBR than males (Table 10)

Watching these areas in the coming quarters will help us to see if there are meaningful patterns.

Note:

The last two "Favorable %" columns show two different ways to look at how strongly participants like the sessions:

- both the "Overall Rating" columns ("Mean" and "Favorable %") are averages of individual averages. The individual averages are calculated <u>from each individual's ratings</u> of the first five questions ("I liked the activities," "I felt comfortable," etc.)
- the "Mean Favorable %" column shows an average of the average in the first five "Favorable %" columns in these tables.

Because not every participant answers every question, these different "Favorable %" numbers are not identical.
